## Attendee Terms and Conditions

### 1. Glossary of Terms

“Attendee” means any individual present at the Conference in any capacity, including but not limited to, Delegates, Exhibitors and Sponsors.

“Symposium” means the IDLS2024 event.

“Event Organiser” means the company who are administering IDLS2024 on behalf of International Data Links Society, being Dot-The-Eye Ltd.

“Event Services Supplier” refers to the venue who are hosting IDLS2024, being the Estoril Congress Center, Cascais, Portugal.

“Exhibitor” refers to any company, business, organisation, partnership, firm or individual whom a stand/booth has been allocated for the purpose of exhibiting at the symposium.

“You” means an attendee, participant or attendee.

### 2. Terms

The following terms and conditions apply to attendees during and in relation to your attendance at IDLS2024 Event.

#### 2.1 Attendees must:

- 2.1.1 Comply with any health, safety and security advice given by the Event Organiser, Event Services Supplier and the Portuguese Government including but not limited to any guidance or procedures relating to public risks, health and safety and COVID-19.
- 2.1.2 Comply with any terms and conditions provided by the Event Services Supplier.
- 2.1.3 Comply with all Applicable Laws.
- 2.1.4 Comply with any reasonable instructions provided by the Event Organiser.
- 2.1.5 Always conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner towards all other Symposium attendees.
- 2.1.6 Wear their name badge at all times and be prepared to show I.D on request.
- 2.1.7 Maintain best practise regarding hygiene wherever possible, for example by frequently washing and/or sanitising hands throughout the event, capturing any coughs or sneezes

in a tissue and disposing of them.

2.1.8 Respect and be kind to everyone at the Symposium regardless of their gender, race, religion, age, sexual orientation, disability or any other aspect of appearance or background.

2.1.9 At the time of entering the venue produce the ID used when booking your ticket. By presenting the ID you confirm that all details present on it are accurate and updated.

### 2.2 Attendees must not:

2.2.1 Be under the influence of drugs or intoxicated.

2.2.2 Be rude, threatening, aggressive, harassing or violent towards any person.

2.2.3 Deliberately cause injury or damage to any other person or property.

2.2.4 Bring animals or pets to the Symposium, unless required for medical purposes.

2.2.5 Undertake unauthorised use of photography, filming or recording.

2.2.6 Act in a way that may damage the Symposiums reputation.

2.2.7 Smoke in any area other than a designated smoking area, this includes E-Cigarettes.

2.2.8 Take part in any leafleting, demonstrations or fundraising that has not been agreed with the Event Organisers.

2.2.9 Intentionally behave in a way that disrupts the Symposium, attendees or exhibitors.

2.3 The International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser reserve the right to remove any attendee from the event, who it is felt is behaving in an unacceptable manner towards any other attendee or conducting themselves in such a way that is likely to bring disrepute upon the International Data Links Society, the Organisers, the Symposium or the venue. Any decision in this respect may be made at the discretion of International Data Links Society and/or the Organisers and will be final.

- 2.4 International Data Links Society, the Event Organisers, the Symposium or the Event Services Supplier shall not be liable to the Attendee for any loss suffered as a result, including the right to a refund, as well as any liability in respect of activities undertaken by other third parties (including Participants, Exhibitors or Attendees) at the Symposium.

### 3. Recording Consent and Photographs

- 3.1 This is a Symposium with networking for which video recording and photography are necessary, including access to the presentations and other activities and for distribution. In addition, video and sound recording and still photography, including but not limited to crowd shots, group videos and photographs and video and still photograph, of Attendees, Speakers, Exhibitors and Sponsors are essential to the activities of the Speakers, Sponsors and Exhibitors and may be a condition of their participation.
- 3.2 Furthermore, a documentary film production “Timber Sweet” will be filming portions of the Symposium for inclusion in the film. The below considerations apply to video and audio content captured by the “Timber Sweet” production crew as well.
- 3.3 You agree and consent that your likeness may be captured in still photo, video, digital photography and other means and may be used across our programmes and applications and on print literature at our events. By attending you grant International Data Links Society, the Event Organiser and AirWing Films/Timber Sweet The Movie explicit permissions, to use your name and likeness in photographs, video and/or digital and hard copy recordings, broadcasts and/or image preservation in digital or paper-based reproductions, in any and all of their applications, sites and publications, without payment or any other consideration, and explicitly waive any and all royalties and indemnify International Data Links Society, the Event Organiser and AirWing Films/Timber Sweet The Movie from any and all liability under any theory of law or equity related to use and/or dissemination of your name/likeness and/or image.
- 3.4 In certain circumstances Participants, Exhibitors and other Attendees may take photographs or conduct filming. In such circumstances The Event Organiser do not have control over what images they collect and their use of such and if you have any questions in relation to this you should discuss this with the relevant third party.

### 4.Substitutions

- 4.1 Substitutions within an organisation may be made provided the Event Organisers are advised in writing before midday on the Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November 2024. If a non-member is substituted for a member, then a membership fee of \$75 will need to be paid.
- 4.2 Name changes will incur an administration fee of \$100 USD.
- 4.3 The last date for accepting name changes will be 15<sup>th</sup> November 2024. Any change received after 15<sup>th</sup> November 2024 will be treated as a cancellation.

### 5. Cancellation Terms

- 5.2 No refunds will be available for either cancellations or no-shows.

### 6. Force Majeure

- 6.1 The International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser accept no responsibility for any loss or inconvenience caused should the event be cancelled due to circumstances outside of their control. They reserve the right to deduct direct expenditure in connection with this event before refunding monies.

### 7. Programme

- 7.1 The Event Organiser and the International Data Links Society will make every effort to provide the programme as advertised. However, it may become necessary, for reasons beyond our control, to make changes to speakers and/or to the timings and content of the programme. The International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser will not be liable for any costs incurred by delegates in relation to such changes.

- 8.2 The Event Organiser does not collect personal data through CCTV and/or webcams at the Symposium, but the Event Services Supplier and/or Exhibitors may do so. Please check with third parties if you have any questions regarding this.

- 9.1 Nothing in these Terms limits any liability which cannot legally be limited, including, where so limited, liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation.
- 9.2 Subject to clause 9.1 above, International Data Links Society and the Event Organisers shall not, in relation to any loss you suffer whilst in attendance or arising out of your attendance at the IDLSoc Symposium, be liable for any:
  - 9.2.1 loss of profit, goodwill, business, loss of agreements or corruption to data;
  - 9.2.2 any consequential, indirect or special losses however arising;
  - 9.2.3 any remote losses that could not reasonably have been foreseen by the parties;

- 9.2.4 any proportion of any loss that was caused or contributed to by any person other than International Data Links Society and the Event Organisers;
- 9.2.5 any proportion of any loss that could reasonably have been mitigated but was not mitigated; or
- 9.2.6 any combination of the above.
- 9.3 Subject to clause 9.1 and 9.2 above, International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser's total liability to you under these Terms and in relation to the IDLSoc Symposium:
- 9.3.1 for loss arising from International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser's failure to comply with its data processing obligations, shall not exceed £10,000; and
- 9.3.2 for all other loss or damage shall not exceed £5,000.
- 9.4 Subject to clause 9.3.1, International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser's do not accept responsibility for any loss you suffer as a result of any loss, damage or theft of personal property whilst attending the IDLSoc Symposium and any personal property you bring to an IDLSoc Symposium is at your own risk.
- 9.5 Subject to clause 9.1 above, International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser assumes no liability in relation to any loss you incur at the IDLSoc Symposium which arises as a result of the Venue and would be the liability of the Venue Owner.
- 9.6 Notwithstanding all precautions taken by International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser's, Venue Owners or any other third parties at an IDLSoc In-Person Event, International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser's shall not be liable in any way for, and Participants, Exhibitors and Attendees by participating in the Event waive any claims with respect to, any issues relating to public health matters generally, and specifically COVID-19, if any Participants, Exhibitors or Attendees contract COVID-19 at the Venue whilst attending an IDLSoc Symposium In-Person Event. - 9.6.1 make your own assessment as to whether you are comfortable to attend and travel to and from the IDLSoc Symposium In-Person Event;
- 9.6.2 take all precautions as recommended by general health and safety authorities (including, but not limited to, travel quarantine or other restrictions or recommendations that may be in place relating to anyone travelling to another country or place where the IDLSoc Symposium In-Person Event is located);
- 9.6.3 comply with any specific precautions or guidelines notified to you by a Venue Owner and/or International Data Links Society and the Event Organiser's as may be relevant for that specific IDLSoc Symposium In-Person Event.
